TREASURER'S REPORT

- No significant issues with outstanding invoices, and no cash-flow issues expected.
- Insurance to be renewed soon.
- NH State business/non-profit report filed and paid.
- All approved the Treasurer's Report.

MAINTENANCE REPORT

- Paving is complete and appreciated.
- Aircraft markings for centerline to be done in the spring.
- Fall cleanup begins in a few weeks.
- Snow plowing: Homeowners should not add snow from their driveways to the berms. To
 prevent damage to grass, the end of Mile High Circle and the taxiway at the south end
 of the runway will be less aggressively plowed than last year.

DESIGN REVIEW COMMITTEE REPORT

- DRC form will be updated to include signature of owner.
- New Owners / Construction:
 - 5 Mile High Circle: Design is approved pending siding and roof selection.
 - 2 Dullas Run: Developer oversight; home delivery expected 2nd week in Dec.
 - 12 and 15 Logan Way: both lots are for sale, with septic laid out and tree removal requested. No trees can be reviewed for removal until there is a house design to review.
 - 4 La Guardia: Owner may visit in November, seeking recommendations for site plans and contractors.

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- 3 Logan Way: no activity. Likely developer oversight.
- 7 Logan Way: still in planning. Approval of metal siding depends on actual samples.
- 17 Logan Way: sold but no activity.
- 29 Logan Way: brush removal to keep the lot clean and clear, but no construction activity.
- 5 Mile High Circle: request DRC form for small roof construction.
