IV. Old Business

- A. Delinquent Accounts. There are still seven delinquent accounts. Three have small balances and three with larger claims. A lien has been requested against the Prudhomme property. - C. 2023-2024 Budget. In the proposed budget, insurance has been increased \$300 and winter maintenance has been increased \$8000. Other line items remain the same. There are 121 properties but only 120 assessments. The assessment is requested to stay the same at \$838. A motion was made by Carl Tyler to accept the proposed budget as written. Motion was seconded by Tom Huckman. Motion passed.
